

**Checklist for Student Visa Application - India**

<b>Form 157A Application to visit Australia for a student (temporary) visa</b>	
<b>Visa Application Charge</b>	
<b>Form 956 Appointment Of A Migration Agent Or Exempt Agent Or Other Authorised Recipient.</b> Please fill in this form if you want a migration agent or other authorised person to receive communications about your application with the department.	
Copies of passport or travel documents of all people included in the application and, if medical examinations have already been undertaken, original passports. NB These copies should include a photocopy of the biodata page and any page showing endorsements or change of name. For current Indian passports a good quality photocopy of the back page with information on parents' names and previous passports. The passport photocopies <u>do not</u> need to be certified.	
Recent passport photo - head and shoulders only, plain background	
Letter of offer issued by education provider <b>or</b> electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) <b>or</b> completed Acceptance Advice for Secondary Exchange Students (AASES) form.	
Evidence of the relationship between members of the family unit certificates (including those who are not joining you in Australia).. Example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Certified copies or notarised copies of birth</li> <li>- Marriage certificate.</li> </ul>	
If married, evidence that the marriage is genuine and ongoing: Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- selection of wedding photos and other photos</li> <li>- affidavits from yourself and third parties</li> <li>- evidence of joint ownership of assets/finances</li> </ul>	
Financial documents, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- evidence of funds held, loan and/or scholarship</li> <li>- evidence of income</li> <li>- financial matrix (see <a href="http://www.india.embassy.gov.au/ndli/vm_studyaus.html">http://www.india.embassy.gov.au/ndli/vm_studyaus.html</a> and <a href="http://www.immi.gov.au/students/students/chooser/index.htm">http://www.immi.gov.au/students/students/chooser/index.htm</a> )</li> </ul>	
Original academic documents: Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- certificates, diplomas, degrees and</li> <li>- academic transcripts</li> </ul>	
English proficiency (for subclasses, 570, 572, 573, 574 & 575): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- IELTS certificate, or</li> <li>- If applicable evidence of sponsorship by your Government or the Australian Government, or</li> <li>- Evidence of sponsorship by multilateral agency (eg World Bank)</li> </ul> <p>For information on this requirement, see <a href="http://www.immi.gov.au/students/students/chooser/index.htm">http://www.immi.gov.au/students/students/chooser/index.htm</a> and follow the links to the relevant checklist</p>
